

Saints Report: 6th Grade Religion/computer

To complete this project you must do the following:

- 1) Choose a saint for your report and ask Mrs. Phelps to approve it (10 points).**
- 2) Using the Internet, research information on your saint; do not print material or information. You must include your hand written notes (summary and paraphrase) with your final draft (10 points)**
- 3) Write a one page, double spaced paper about your saint. This should be in MLA format, with citations included (10 points). Mr. Federle will teach you how to do this.**

Your paper must contain the following elements:

First paragraph: tell where the saint was born (date and country) and something about his or her childhood (10 points).

Second paragraph: talk about the life of the saint. Was your saint always saintly in his or her

behavior, or did he or she have problems in life (10 points)?

Third paragraph: tell how this person changed his or her life. What happened your saint's life that made the church consider him or her for sainthood (10 points)?
